The <u>assistive listening system</u> has been installed which will allow those who are hard of hearing to listen with clarity during worship services. Six receivers with headphones are available with simple on/off and volume buttons. They will be available to anyone in a special charging station in the Choir Room on the radio control counter. You may also use the receiver on your own cell phone with a free app to listen with personal hearing aids that have Bluetooth capability.
